Calgary’s Oval X-Treme women’s hockey team will play the United States Selects in the opening game of the tournament on Monday, February 9, 2009 at the EnCana Events Centre. While residents experience Olympic-calibre women’s hockey, proceeds from the event will benefit two local organizations – Dawson Creek Minor Hockey and the Ark Christian Youth Centre.
