



## Capital One Cup Overview

The race for the Capital One Cup returns as the world's top men's and women's teams battle it out this season as they strive to win one of the sport's toughest trophies.

An annual points-based competition designed to reward the teams who deliver the highest, cumulative results across all the Capital One Grand Slam of Curling events each season, the Capital One Cup will award a total of \$170,000 (CDN) in prize money to this season's top three men's and women's teams.

**First place    \$50,000                      Second place    \$25,000                      Third place    \$10,000**

Throughout the 2009-10 season, teams will earn a point value based on their performance during selected Capital One Grand Slam of Curling events. Points are doubled during the season-ending Grey Power Players' Championship tournament.

In 2009-10, men will receive Capital One Cup points based on their results at **The National**, the BDO Classic Canadian Open and the Grey Power Players' Championship. Women will receive Capital One Cup points at the Trail Appliances Autumn Gold Curling Classic, the Manitoba Lotteries Women's Curling Classic and the Grey Power Players' Championship.

### *First Four Selected Events*

1st place	12 pts
2nd place	9 pts
3rd place	7 pts
4th place	5 pts
One point per win in the Preliminary Round. Non-playoff teams only.	

### *Grey Power Players' Championship*

1st place	24 pts
2nd place	18 pts
3rd place	14 pts
4th place	10 pts
Two points per win in the Preliminary Round. Non-playoff teams only.
