WALKING TRACK
REOPENING PLAN

As we prepare to open the Wayne and Bev Dahlen Walking Track on November 2, 2020, Spectra Venue Management has been working with the City of Dawson Creek, Northern Health and Provincial Health authorities to create a reopening plan to ensure the health and safety of all users. Since many of these measures will be new and will evolve, we want to be ensure our users are aware of these changes. We welcome any user comments or suggestions during this first phase of reopening. NEW WALKING TRACK REGISTRATION

- The walking track will be open for scheduled blocks of time and is limited to 15 users at a time. Schedules can be found at www.dawsoncreekeventscentre.com
- Pre-registration is recommended and can be made in advance through www.dawsoncreek.ca/register or by calling 250-782-7946 (Kenn Borek Aquatic Centre) or 250-784-3604 (Community Services). The Encana Events Centre (EEC) is not taking registration requests. You must have or create an account to register online.
- If registering online, each person visiting the facility must have a time slot reserved. (For example, families and care givers must have a time slot booked for each person attending). Maximum of 4 people per group
- Users who pre-registered will be admitted first into KBAC; users who have not registered must wait until all registered guests have signed in. If there is space within the time block you will be allowed to register at KBAC.

ACCESSING THE WALKING TRACK

- Users will continue to access the walking track through the Kenn Borek Aquatic Centre (KBAC). Arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before your start time as the KBAC as doors will not open early.
- KBAC will open the doors to the EEC at the session start time.
- A seating area to change shoes will be provided in the walking track lobby on the 3rd level of the EEC. Please bring all belongings up with you and store in this area. Clean, non-marking shoes must be worn on the track.
- The stairs and elevator within the EEC will be available to access the track. One group or “cohort” is permitted in the elevator at a time
- Users can access the track at any time during their registered block.

LEAVING THE WALKING TRACK

- Users will be given a 10 minute warning via posted signage before the track is closed
- Users must promptly vacate the track at the end of their session. Users on the track after this time will be asked to leave to allow for cleaning
- Users must follow signage and leave the EEC through the Lower Lobby doors. Signing out at the KBAC is no longer required

WALKING TRACK GUIDELINES

- All users will travel in the same direction – directional signage will be posted
- Track will be divided to have a walking lane and running lane. Users must move to a single file to allow space for passing
- Personal belongings must be left in the shoe change area and are not permitted on the track. Please leave valuables at home
- A small number of seats will be available on the track for users to rest if necessary
- No leaning on the railings or stopping on the track
- Bikes, scooters, rollerblades and Heelies are not permitted. Strollers and walking aides are welcome
- One set of washrooms will be open on the walking track

USER SAFETY

Enhanced health and safety measures have been taken for users of the walking track and staff of the EEC. All posted instructions must be adhered to when using the walking track. All standard COVID-19 protocols will apply on the walking track and at the EEC.

COVID SAFETY CHECK

By entering the South Peace Multiplex, you are confirming the following:

1. I do not have any unexplained, new, or worsening symptoms (of any severity) that may include one or more of the following: cough, runny nose, sore throat, flu like symptoms, shortness of breath, muscle aches or joint pains, fatigue, or fever (38 C or 100.4 F).
2. I have not travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days.
3. I do not have a positive test for COVID-19.
4. I have not been exposed to someone who is under testing for COVID-19 or has been confirmed to having COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
5. I will maintain 2 metres of physical distancing.

ADDITIONAL USER SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Masks are recommended but not required
- Sanitizer stations will be available throughout the EEC
- If users need assistance, or in the event of an emergency a radio will be available in the rest area to contact EEC staff
- An AED is located on the walking track. Contact EEC staff and dial 911 in the event of an emergency

CLEANING

- At the end of each session, EEC staff will disinfect all touchpoints (including but not limited to door handles, elevator buttons, railings, chairs, and washrooms)
- A full clean and disinfection of the walking track and all spaces utilized by walking track users will be performed when the walking track is closed for the day
- Help us keep the walking track clean, by only wearing clean, non-marking shoes

CLEANING PROCEDURES

The disinfection procedures listed are in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. These cleaning measures are in addition to regular facility cleaning procedures.

The risk of exposure to cleaning staff is inherently low; however cleaning staff should wear disposable gloves and appropriate PPE for all cleaning tasks, including handling trash. PPE should be removed carefully to avoid contamination of the wearer and surrounding area. Work uniforms should be washed after each shift.

High touch surfaces such as door handles, elevator buttons, railings, chairs, and washrooms will be sanitized after each session and be part of the deep clean when the track is closed for the day.

A cleaning log has been developed and includes where, what, and how often cleaning is occurring. Log sheets are completed/signed off each time cleaning occurs.

Elevator

- Touch point cleaning of elevator buttons and railings with a viral disinfectant will occur after each time block
- A thorough cleaning of the elevator with a viral disinfectant will occur after the track has closed for the day

Stairwells

- Touch point cleaning of railings with a viral disinfectant will occur after each time block
- A thorough cleaning of the stairwells with a viral disinfectant will occur after the track has closed for the day

Walking Track Lobby/Shoe Change Area & Rest Area

- All chairs and touchpoint areas will be cleaned with a viral disinfectant after each time block and after the track has closed for the day
- Electrostatic sprayers will be used in these areas after each time block and after the track has closed for the day

Walking Track & Washrooms

- Touch point cleaning of all high touch areas including railings, door handles, faucets and toilets will occur after each time block
- A thorough cleaning and sanitization of the washrooms will occur after the track has closed for the day
- The track surface will be scrubbed after the track has closed for the day
- Electrostatic sprayers will be used in these areas after each time block and after the track has closed for the day
